"Our storage area is created like a greenhouse and it is fully airconditioned," explains Michael Bank, who is responsible for the total concept of the project. "For this, we can provide the storage of plants and our customers do not have to take the risk." With its new logistics platform, GASA Germany offers its customers a complete range of Mediterranean plants throughout the whole season. Furthermore, customers can order just the actual required volumes, which can be delivered just in time. Within the value chain, every core process has been optimized. This ensures an enormous speed when it comes to the distribution of goods throughout Europe. "We have been able to increase our flexibility extremely. Especially in spring, this is very important to our customers," says Michael Bank.

The day-to-day business is based on a seasonally changing program of plants from Italy, Spain, Greece, Portugal, France and Turkey. Because of a constantly updated stock list, the plants can also be offered in small amounts. A long-standing partnership with the best producers, as well as regular trips to ensure the quality of the plants form the basis for a constant offer of top products.
